MISSIONS FOCUS

Our Gr. 8 class is participating in a fundraising partnership with edu-deo ministries to raise funds that address global and gender inequalities. This ties closely with Christ's mandate and their Geography curriculum's focus on global inequalities. The money raised will help build 6 new bathrooms in Zambian schools. This will allow many girls the opportunity to attend school since there will be privacy and adequate facilities to meet their needs as they grow older.

6 hours ... 6 bathrooms ... 6 schools ... and many lives will be changed.

For 6 hours on Fri/Apr/29 our Gr. 8 class will remain silent.

The Grade 8 class will not talk so that other voices can be heard. On that day they will be doing silent activities and serving around the school. Each Gr. 8 student has a paper copy
