A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

I've been thinking a lot lately about the season of Lent that we are currently in. As some of you know, I grew up in the Salvation Army and this period of time between Ash Wednesday and the Thursday before Good Friday was called 'Self Denial'. We were encouraged to deny ourselves something, but I don't ever remember being told why. I remember 'denying' myself my allowance and bringing it to church to put in the offering plate, or forgoing eating pizza (which I loved). At some point, a very wise, godly woman who brought me to the Lord and continued to shepherd me for years afterwards, suggested that I might try giving up, at least for a short time, my tendency towards bossiness and always wanting to be right! (Sigh - an ongoing struggle!)

It wasn't until I was a young adult that I put the pieces together and realized that the period of time we called 'Self Denial' was called Lent in other churches and that they, too, had the tradition of giving up something. Today, I overheard a Kindergarten student say that, in her family, she had given up talking at the dinner table for Lent! This made me laugh, but it got me thinking, "Do families and/or churches still practice the idea of giving something up for Lent or has this practice fallen by the wayside?"

I realize that the purpose for self-sacrificing varies slightly in different churches, but from what I've read and understand, by giving up something that is hard for us to do, it helps us share in Jesus' suffering and draws us closer to God as we contemplate the sacrificial gift of Jesus' death for each of us.




We will be hosting our annual **Grandparents' & Special Friends' Day.**
