# Thoughts from our Principal ...

A couple Sundays ago, I was in church, sitting in our family's "regular pew" – second row from the back, left side facing the pulpit. The music team had started to play probably their third song by this time, most people settling in and some rushing in the last minute. Typical Sunday morning.

I noticed the row of people sitting near the front, was mostly filled up already with a family – looked like two grandparents, their daughter, her husband, three young kids, likely grade 1 to grade 7, I am guessing. I think on the other end of the pew there might have been a friend of the grandmother, a sister, maybe a niece and her baby, cute baby. The pew was getting pretty full and it was 15 minutes into the service by now. Then came another person, and his wife with another little baby, cute, but a bit squeaky. Everyone looked over at the three of them, shuffled over, and then looked back again at the latest additions to their cozy seating situation. I counted maybe 12 or 13 people by this time, maybe more. I think I lost count. I was supposed to be paying attention to the pastor who was about to start the message.

Simple observation. What struck me about this little event was the shuffling over. In a church pew, we can get possessive about where we sit and how much room we get. But the act of "shuffling over" was a natural response by a group of "sitters" for a bunch of "standers." And the "standers" could have picked somewhere else to sit, but they chose this pew. The sitters and standers knew they belonged together. They adjusted for each other, looked out for each other, probably felt a bit squished for each other. But here they were, all 13 of them in one pew, no complaints. In fact, they seemed pretty content, at least from looking at the backs of their heads.

It made me think that as "sitters" and "standers" here at WCS, we shuffle over, adjusting and looking out for each other, finding ways to show people they belong.

When a new face joins our class...we shuffle over.

When someone joins our soccer game or lunch time discussion ... we shuffle over.

When a visitor comes to WCS...we shuffle over.

When we "shuffle over" we are treating others with kindness and respect:

- We speak kindly to each other, saying our "Please, Thank you's, and Pardon me" when we don't listen well.
- We put others ahead of us opening the door for them or letting them choose what they want to do or play.
- We look at them in the eyes when we talk and listen to what they say.
- We greet them with a "Hello," and say "Good bye" when we leave.
- We forgive and/or ask for forgiveness when we have hurt them, trying better next time.

Here at WCS, we need to keep working on a culture of kindness and respect. We belong to the same family and love the same Lord and Saviour, the one whose death and resurrection we are celebrating during this time of Lent and Easter.

The act of "shuffling over" – as "sitters" or "standers" – is the act of showing love. We love because HE loved us first.
