2021-22 School Supply List

Some items to consider when preparing to come to Grade 5:

1. Plan for in class hydration. A full, clean water bottle should come each day.
2. All PE classes will be outside this year. Please ensure that your child comes to school with weather-appropriate clothing every day. Gym uniforms will not be ordered this year.
3. Please label items like shoes, plastic containers, etc. with student's name to reduce confusion with lost or mislaid items.
4. Keep extra supplies at home to be brought to school later. They are often lost or used as toys.
5. While hand sanitizer will be provided by the school, students are permitted to bring a MINI bottle of sanitizer for their desk. **Please ensure that they hand sanitizers do NOT have any fragrance.**
6. Students are required to wear a face covering/mask again this year while indoors. Please ensure your child has either a disposable or cloth (reusable) face covering every day. It is recommended, especially for those choosing to wear disposable masks, to have at least 2 additional masks available at school at all times. Should a student forget to bring a mask, the school will provide them with one.

Here are the items you need:

- 1 pencil case that can fit into your desk (preferable nylon dual zipper)
- 1 30cm clear ruler
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 24 pencil crayons
- Two 1" binders or one 2" binder (whichever you prefer)
- Scissors
- 1 French/English dictionary
- 1 reusable water bottle
- 1 backpack to hang on hook
- 1 lunch bag
- 1 calculator (does not need to be scientific)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 personal size bottle of hand sanitizer
- 200-400 sheets of lined 3-hole paper
- 1 art sketch book (minimum 80 pages, 8.5 x 11")
- Pens: blue, red and black
- Pencils (HB and mechanical)
- Erasers
- Highlighters
- Crayola markers
- 4 large gluesticks
- Math compass set
- Indoor shoes (appropriate for physical education)

Please note: WCS will supply index dividers at the start of the year. Students will have the opportunity to order instruments (ukulele) and music books through the school later in the fall.
