# Thoughts from our Principal ...

Last week during Wednesday Worship, Mrs. Well led us in a time of "Looking back" and reflecting on 2024. She used the image of a rear-view mirror and taking time to see what the year gone by was like – Where did we go? What did we do?

One of the main questions that come out of reflecting on the past is also the opportunity to focus – or refocus – on who God is and what He wants for us. Using the armour of God also helps us do the things He asks of us, focusing on Him in the day-to-day tasks. The armour, as you remember, is our theme for this school year.

Let's use another analogy to help us think about "armour."

Well, it's football playoff season! In our house, we watched a few football games on our TV yesterday. In the first game, we watched the Buffalo Bills beat the Denver Broncos, 31 to 7. While I am not an NFL fan, I do recognize that there's a lot to the game that blows my mind. We saw one play where the Bills, Number 26 Ty Johnson, scooped up a throw by Josh Allen and made an impressive touchdown (although I don't love the celebrating that players do for the cameras, to be honest). To slide on the ground and be able to scrape that football into his arms before it hit the ground and make a touchdown is easier because of his footwear, his helmet and all the equipment on his body. Now, if you watch a play where the defensive players push against their opponents so that no one gets to their QB, then you'll also notice all the body-to-body contact and roughness. Needless to say, the players are huge and the tackles are crushing. The crunch of helmets and bodies on the field, sometimes with snow or rain, do not make this sport a walk in the park. So, whether on the defensive line or the offensive line, whether a running back or the QB, everyone on the team wears protective gear.
