

A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

Several years ago, the Intermediate Division (Gr. 7 & 8) staff and I began to discuss how, and if, we were preparing our young adults to go out into the world with a clear understanding of what they believed and how to defend it in a culture that is, more often than not, anti-Christian. We knew we were giving them a firm foundation in Biblical facts, scripture truths and worldview, but we were not as certain that we were doing all we could do to prepare them for the culture/world they would be engaging in as young adults. Would they be able to stand up to challenges to their faith? Would they be able to, not just defend their faith, but also to engage in our culture to help redeem it? As a result, we became much more intentional about including apologetics in our curriculum using several methods including (but not limited to), 'The Case for Christ – Young Reader's Edition by Lee Strobel'.

Recently, I was sent an email from Timothy Christian School (TCS) in Barrie. They are hosting a weekend called 'EQUIP' that is designed for young people (Gr. 6-12) on the Friday night and for parents/caregivers/teachers/ pastors on the Saturday. Below is the email they sent me along with registration forms (attached) for both events. I encourage parents with children in Gr. 6-8 to consider attending.

"We have planned a Worldview/Apologetics Conference entitled 'EQUIP'. This conference will be geared towards equipping both Youth and Adults towards a Biblically confident faith in Christ. As a school, we have felt the growing need to equip students with Biblical Worldview training that will help them to understand their faith, the gospel, and why it is reasonable and worth living for in our current culture. Our heart is to see Christian students and educators be equipped to face challenges they encounter and to be emboldened to respond to these challenges with both truth and with grace.

Below is a quick summary of the event. There are 2 components to this conference.

Friday night is a Youth Event for students in Gr. 6-12. There will be a live worship band, food/snacks, fun crowd games/activities, and 2 'World Class'. Speakers ~ Tim Barnett and Brett Kunkle

Saturday is a full day Conference (9:00 am - 4:30 pm) with 3 keynote speakers and break-out sessions, hosted at TCS (Barrie). We are really excited about the following speakers that will be joining us for the event!

Tim Barnett - Stand to Reason (Toronto, On)Brett Kunkle - Maven Ministries (California)Alan Shlemon - Stand to Reason (California)Wesley Huff - Power to Change (Toronto, On)Elizabeth Urbanowitz - Creator of the Foundation Worldview Apologetics Curriculum Series

These are all people who have been involved in equipping children and youth within their ministries. The main focus of Saturday's event will be to equip parents, Youth Pastors, youth leaders, teachers, young adults, etc. with tools to help walk alongside their children/families towards a Biblically confident and solid belief in Christ and His work of salvation for them.
