EMPTY TOMB ROLLS

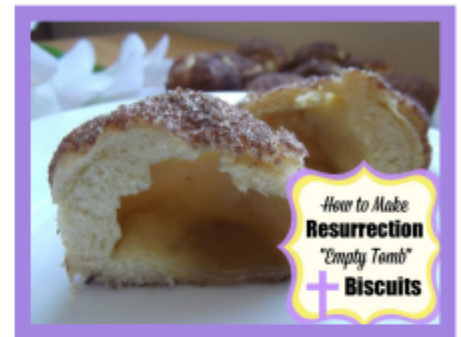
Teaching kids about the true meaning of Easter with Empty Tomb Rolls is easy and makes a lasting impact ... and they taste good too!

Ingredients

- ◇ 1 (10 ounce) package jumbo refrigerated crescent rolls
- ◇ 1/4 cup sugar
- ◇ 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- ◇ 8 large marshmallows
- ◇ 1/4 cup butter, melted

Instructions

- ◇ Preheat oven to 375°. Prepare muffin pan (preferably jumbo size) with non-stick cooking spray.
- ◇ Separate rolls into 8 triangles and set aside. Combine sugar and cinnamon in a small bowl.
- ◇ Dip each marshmallow into butter, then roll in cinnamon-sugar and place on a triangle dough.
- ◇ Pinch dough around marshmallow, sealing all edges. **Seal it well or marshmallow will escape.**
- ◇ Dip tops of dough into the remaining butter and then into the cinnamon-sugar.
- ◇ Place rolls with the sugar side up into prepared muffin cups.
- ◇ Bake at 375° for 13 - 15 minutes. Eat while they are still warm! Yummy!



While baking with your child ...

- ⇒ Read the Easter story from Matthew 27-28, Mark 15-16, Luke 23-24, and/or John 19-20.
- ⇒ Explain that Jesus represents the marshmallow.
- ⇒ After Jesus died on the cross he was wrapped in linen. Roll in butter and cinnamon.
- ⇒ Then Jesus was placed in a tomb. Crescent roll dough.
- ⇒ On the 3rd day - Jesus rose from the dead! Open the cooked roll to find no marshmallow – just as the tomb, it is empty!
