# A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

On Friday our teachers had a P.A. Day (profession activity) to work on progress reports for their students. Last year we switched from three full report cards to a November progress report and full report cards in February and June. Our new report cards (from a few years ago) are a lot more work but tell parents a lot more information about their child's learning. This new format worked well last year. The November progress report is intended to give parents a small glimpse into their child's work habits, achievements, and suggestions for growth. If your child has an area blackened out it may mean that your child has not completed enough of the work for that subject or that your child is struggling with English, thus they are not capable of doing the work yet. Please read the comments that the teacher has written. The comment area takes the most time and tells parents the most. Some teachers use this as a place to write a bit about what their students have been learning. Some teachers highlight students' work habits. All teachers will include areas where your child is doing well and areas and ideas for growth. If your child is in Grade 4 or higher (or lower grades, at your discretion), I highly recommend that you read the report with your child and use it as a jumping board for discussion. Ask your child what they think of their report? Do they think it is accurate? If not, why? These reports are being followed up with Parent/Teacher Conferences next week. Again, Grades 4 and up are welcome to include the students. This is completely up to parents and students. The teachers are looking forward to talking with you about your child's progress. Hopefully this is not the first time you will be talking to your child's teacher! Just a reminder that the sign up for interviews closes this Friday (see announcement further down).

This Saturday marks one of the highlights of the school year- our annual Christmas Bazaar! The school will be a buzz with a children's craft room, a rummage sale, a Dutch and candy room (along with cheese, flowers, chocolate letters and frozen food pick up), and a gym full of vendors, yummy food and visiting.
