A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

I can hardly believe that we will be turning our calendar pages (for those of us who still use paper calendars!) to December this week and the season of Advent began vesterday!

As we look forward to our Christmas Break, many families are hoping to travel outside of Canada. I just wanted to take this opportunity to remind all parents of the current protocols regarding students (both fully vaccinated and non-vaccinated) returning to school after travelling outside this country.

As per Memo addressed to Principals of Private Schools (dated November 18, 2021) from Julia Danos, Executive Lead - Education Reopening Secretariat:

UNVACCINATED STUDENTS

"Individuals must follow Federal testing/guarantine requirements upon return from travel. This includes not attending school or child care for the 14 days following a return from international travel for individuals advised to quarantine or not attend school/child care upon their return. While unvaccinated children under the age of 12 who travelled internationally with a fully vaccinated companion are exempt from federal quarantine, they are not permitted to attend school or child care for 14 days following their return."

VACCINATED STUDENTS

"Generally, individuals (staff and students) who are fully vaccinated are exempt from Federal guarantine and may continue to attend school or child care."

In other words, if a student is not fully vaccinated, regardless of guarantine/testing requirements or vaccination status of the people they travelled with, they may **NOT** return to school until 14 days following their return to Canada.

If the student is fully vaccinated (currently this would ONLY apply to students who are 12+ years), they MAY return to school upon re-entering Canada.

Please keep these protocols in mind as you make your plans for Christmas Break.

In addition, please remember that our teachers will not be able to provide full online learning for students staying at home for 14 days. After just returning to work from 2 weeks away, teachers will need a few days to get their classes back on the learning track. Parents should reach out to their child's teacher to see what work could be provided through Teams and/or picked up.



IMPORTANT

Since Mrs. Venneri must track every student's travel plans (if going outside of Canada), in order to comply with Toronto Public Health protocols, be sure to email the office with your plans prior to Fri/Dec/17. Please include in your email the date of departure. date of return, country your family is visiting, and the date you plan to send your child back to school.
