

### A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

November is a very full month! I just want to take a moment to go over 2 of the many important things that will be happening this month:

**PROGRESS REPORTS** - As of this school year (2022/23), we have moved to a 2-term year. Term 1 runs from September to the end of January and Term 2 runs from February to the end of June. There will be 2 full Report Cards sent home for each of those terms (Term 1 Report Card goes home on Fri/Feb/03 and Term 2 Report Card on Fri/Jun/23 - the last day of school). We are introducing a Progress Report which will be distributed on Fri/Nov/18. While these Progress Reports do not contain grades, they do let you know whether your child is below, meeting, or exceeding the expectations of the teacher in each subject area, as well as work habits and learning skills. Teachers will also provide general comments. The Progress Report is followed by Parent-Teacher Conferences being held on Tue/Nov/22 @ 6:00 pm - 9:00 pm and Wed/Nov/23 @ 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm to give you an opportunity to discuss your child's progress directly with their teacher.

**PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES** - Based on the positive response we received when we held Parent-Teacher Conferences remotely during the past 2 years (easier for parents, often both parents can attend, parents from outside Canada can attend), the decision was made to continue with that format this year. These meetings will be held using Teams instead of Zoom. The reason for this change is that, during the pandemic, Zoom gave all educators unlimited time for Zoom meetings at \$0 cost. This has now been cancelled and all Zoom meetings are limited to 40 minutes. Because our teachers provide all parents with 1 link, it would be impossible for us to continue using Zoom. You will find on the document attached to The Weekly, instructions for booking your online conference. Once your meeting is booked, you will receive an email containing the Teams link. HANG ON TO THAT LINK! If you will be using a cell phone or iPad for your conference, you will need to download the Teams app. If you plan to use a laptop or desktop computer, you only need to choose the option 'continue on this browser' - you do not need to have Teams loaded on your computer. After that, everything will run much like it did on Zoom.

- Services through Canadian Military Family Resource Centres;

- Veterans' drop-in centres and meals-on-wheels program;
- Sponsorship of cadet and youth programs.
