A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

Last week was a very busy week! Monday, the teachers enjoyed some excellent time of professional development. Tuesday, we had Alex from the NED Project here (thanks to all those who bought yo-yo's to support their presentation). Thursday, the boys' and girls' soccer teams participated in their tournament (thanks to all the parents who drove, Mr. Thiessen and Mr. Evre for coaching and the students who did their best!). Finally, Friday we observed Truth and Reconciliation Day.

I was away Thursday and Friday at the Fall Edvance Leadership Conference. It was entitled "Unity in Christ: Leading Diversity Conversations in Christian Schools." Our main speaker was Dr. Esau McCaulley, a pastor, professor, and writer. We struggled with what it means to be united in Christ and what it means to be schools that welcome diversity. We listened to stories from people of colour about their experiences in mostly white Christian Schools. We sat in the discomfort, while still reaching out to the Spirit for guidance, forgiveness, and unity. The conference got me thinking a lot about our school. WCS is quite different from many Christian Schools, especially the rural ones. We are ethnically and denominationally very diverse. Yet, are we truly welcoming? Is everyone who wants to be at our table there? One thing that really resonated with me was the topic of the questions we ask others. Dr. McCaulley mentioned that in southern Alabama, where he is from, people often greet with "Where are you from?" However, for many others, that question gives the message that the person you are asking is a foreigner that doesn't belong. For someone who is white, that wouldn't offend me at all. However, for others, it may make them feel unwelcome or an outsider.

So, what were my main take aways from this conference? First, I need to be very careful what words I use. Second, I need to recognize my white privilege and biases and how they might affect a school that is so wonderfully diverse. Third, I need to welcome and be open to criticism. If I have ever said something that made you feel marginalized or uncomfortable, please tell me! I want to lean into the discomfort so that I can continue to grow. And finally, I was reminded that we are ALL fearfully and wonderfully made in God's image! Our God is a diverse God! He meets each of us where we are at any point of our own journeys! Let's praise His mighty name!
