We started our visit with worship where we learned about how pastors are a blessing to those in their churches, and how we, as students and teachers at WCS, can be a blessing to others in our classrooms, our homes, our churches, our neighbourhoods and even our whole world! It was wonderful to have the worship team leading the singing portion of worship. Thank you to John T., Zaynne, Grace W., Yuna S., and a group of Grade 1 girls for doing such an amazing job. After worship I had an opportunity to chat with the pastors about what WCS does and what our mission and vision are. Mr. Alex Krupin, a Board member and WCS parent who is also a pastor, shared more about why his family chose to send their children to WCS. Martin Luther was born on November 10, 1483 in Germany. He was a theologian and religious reformer who was the catalyst of the 16th-century Protestant Reformation.

Through his words and actions, Luther precipitated a movement that reformulated certain basic tenets of Christian belief and resulted in the division of Western Christendom between Roman Catholicism and the new Protestant traditions - mainly Lutheranism and Calvinism.

Martin Luther is one of the most influential figures in the history of Christianity!
