THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

AFTER SCHOOL PICK-UP: Things went amazing last week! Thank you for being so quick with picking up your children. Just a reminder that the reserved spots are only for the names on the red sign. Parents pay for these spots at the yearly fundraising dinner, so please respect the signs.
