IMPORTANT INFORMATION re: STUDENTS OF CELL PHONE USAGE

We are aware that many students come to school with cell phones - some with data and some not, depending on the needs and wishes of individual families. In an effort to create an environment where parents can be confident that no child will be viewing/listening to something on a cell phone belonging to one of their peers that they do not want their child to have access to, we have a school wide policy that clearly states that cell phones MAY NOT be used on school property. That means that as soon as your child comes on to school in the morning, all cell phones must be put away in their backpack. That cell phone must remain on silent during the day in their backpack or locker. The 'no cell phone use' policy also applies to after school care and any other activity on school property that a student may be involved with after regular school hours. Parents need to be aware that, if you text/call your child on a cell phone during the day, they will not be able to access their phone. If you have a message that you need to get to your child, please call the office and we will ensure that message is delivered to your child. We recognize that there are, on occasion, extenuating circumstances where a child must use their cell phone to contact a parent about last minute pick up arrangements for example. In that case, the student should ask a teacher if they may use their cell phone and explain the reason. The teacher will give permission but the phone must be returned to their backpack or locker immediately. The students have been told that if they are caught using their cell phone on school property without permission, their phone will be confiscated until the end of the day. Normally, an email will also go home to the parent(s) explaining why the phone was taken for the balance of the day.
