A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

Well, our first week went extremely well! A few tears, a few frazzled looking parents, and a few exhausted teachers, but, all in all, there were very few hiccups! This week, I just want to share a few important things that are not in order of importance:

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

We recently purchased new Math curriculum for Grades 7/8. Things have changed considerably in the past few years and student 'textbooks' are now, apparently, soft sided. In an effort to ensure these 'text books' (and I use that term loosely) last as long as possible, we are going to put plastic coverings on each of them. Our previous librarian, Hetty Veldkamp, has done this on hundreds of books and is willing to show other people how it is done. To quote her, "it is not difficult, just a bit tedious". She has ordered the plastic covering for us (it is adhesive) and we should have it in a week or so. I am looking for 2 -4 volunteers who would be willing to be 'trained' and then take home some plastic and books to cover. Please let the office know if you would be willing to do this.

VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

Speaking of volunteers ... I just want to remind everyone that the required volunteer hours program is cancelled again this year. However, there will be times when volunteers are needed (see request above). If you volunteer for a task or a field trip, please send the office an email outlining your family name, the nature of the task, and the # of hours you volunteered. These hours will be tracked by Mrs. Venneri and applied to your required 30 Volunteer Hours for the 2022-2023 school year.

VULNERABLE SECTOR SCREENING (VSS)

All volunteers in the school are required to have a current (less than 3 years old) VSS on file in the office. Due to the pandemic and the elimination of all opportunities to volunteer last year, there are many people who no longer have a current VSS on file because they have expired. If you think you may be one of those people and you hope to be able to volunteer for the limited number of opportunities that will be available this year (we hope to have some field trips, drivers for at least the soccer tournament, pasta lunches etc.), please contact the office to make arrangements to get a current VSS.
