WCS IS A NUT-FREE ENVIRONMENT

Please check labels if you are not sure what's in a food item. Your child should NOT come to school with Nutella, peanut butter, etc. Keep in mind that even when you are providing food for school wide events (Christmas Bazaar, Grandparent's Day, etc.) all food items should be completely nut free.

PARKING LOT ETIQUETTE

Now that we are into our 3rd week of school, a reminder is needed about drop-off and pick-up procedures. The parking lot is property of Willowdale Christian Reformed Church. They have graciously given the WCS community (staff/parents) permission to use their lot from Monday to Friday. The entrance to the lot is narrow, but sufficient for 2 vehicles to pass each other if done slowly and carefully. The cones are placed strategically to prevent people from parking in spots that would further narrow the entrance. Based on my observations over the past 2 weeks, we all need to be reminded of the following:

- SLOW DOWN! There are children/parents walking across the parking lot and behind cars as they make their way
 to the gate.
- BACK UP CAREFULLY! Children are short and cannot always be seen behind your vehicle.
- When heading to the gate, please walk between the fence and the cars parked along it whenever possible. (There will be times during the winter months when snowbanks make that impossible.)
- When parking along the fence, be sure to leave enough distance between your vehicle and the fence to allow for parents/students to walk through without difficulty.
- When dropping off your child, please do NOT stop to let them out as you enter or exit the parking lot. Please pull into a parking spot and then allow your child to exit your vehicle. Stopping as you enter or leave blocks the smooth flow of traffic.
- Do NOT park in the 2 reserved spots for our families who have purchased the rights to those spots for the 2022/23 school year as part of our fundraising efforts last year. These parking spots will be up for auction again in the spring for the 2023/24 school year.
- Do not park in the handicapped spots unless you need them due to mobility restrictions.
- Because we have so many vehicles using the parking lot in the morning and afternoons, it would be helpful if people parked as far back in the lot as possible when they arrived.
- Please do not park near the gate in the morning before 8:10 am. Our 2 school busses pull into that north lot in the morning, the largest bus does not leave until approximately 8:10 am. The bus needs room for students to disembark and load safely. If you bring your child before the bus arrives, please park in a proper parking spot.
- In general, we all need to be hyper vigilant to protect our students!
