A Few Thoughts from our Principal ...

Last week Friday our school participated in the Terry Fox Run which raises money for cancer research. Terry Fox was a young Canadian who lost his leg and then his life to cancer. After losing his leg, he was



inspired to run across Canada to raise money for cancer research. At the time his goal was \$1 for every Canadian. His run was cut short just outside of Thunder Bay (if you ever drive that way, stop at the memorial- it is very moving) when his cancer was back, this time in his lungs. Terry died on June 28, 1981. Many of you probably weren't even born yet (I was in Grade 1).

Why do we do the Terry Fox Run at WCS? The end of our Mission Statement of WCS is "to live a life of service for Christ." A big part of serving Christ is teaching our students to look beyond our school walls.

It includes looking in our world for ways that we can help others, ways that we can share Christ's love in our actions. The last couple of weeks of school our students learned more about Terry Fox and how his actions showed that he wanted to help many people and he has extended that help beyond his life span. Students often ask, "Was Terry Fox a Christian?" I answer with, "I'm not sure. Why do you ask?" Often it is because our students view Christians as people who help, people who care about others, people who will do something that will make a difference in this world. And why? Because we love Christ! Also, this Friday our school is observing another important day in Canada: Truth and Reconciliation Day (Orange Shirt Day). This is a day when Canadians remember and reflect on the history of Residential schools and how Indigenous peoples have been treated. By learning about our history, we can learn how to make changes so that we don't make the same mistakes again. At WCS we feel that is important to teach our children about our country and our world. That is how we equip them "to live a life of service for Christ."
